## Key:

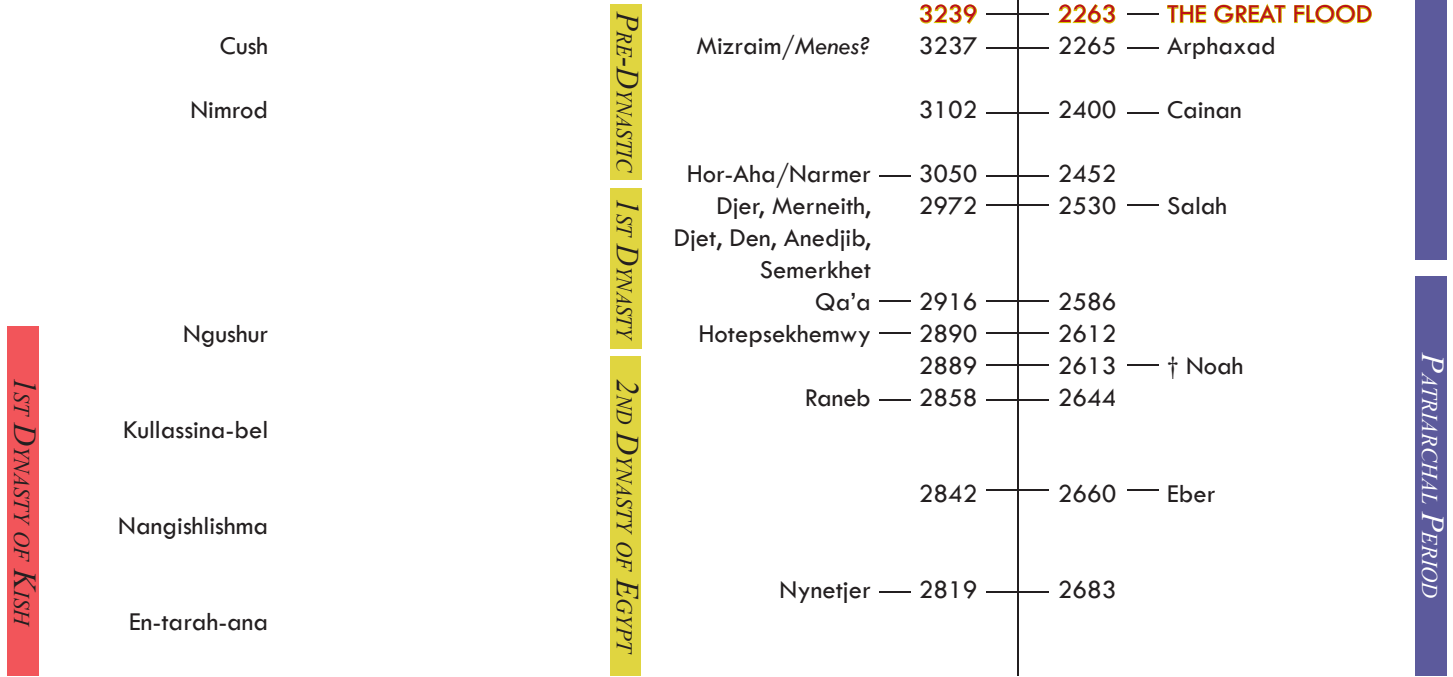
Dates to the right of the line are from the time of the creation, (*Anno Mundi*, AM). Dates to the left of the line are according to conventional dating (BC or AD). Events to the right of the line are Biblical figures and events and those most directly effecting the Old or New Testament Church. Those to the left are world events and rulers.

## Note on Dates:

All dates before the construction of the Temple are dependant upon a literal reading of I Kings 6:1 which states that there were 480 years between the beginning of the Exodus and the beginning of construction on Solomon's temple. This reading requires that the 450 years of rule by the judges, and the 40 year reign of Saul, mentioned in the New Testament must be the total of several overlapping periods of time (See Samuel J. Schulz, *The Old Testament Speaks*, 103-104).

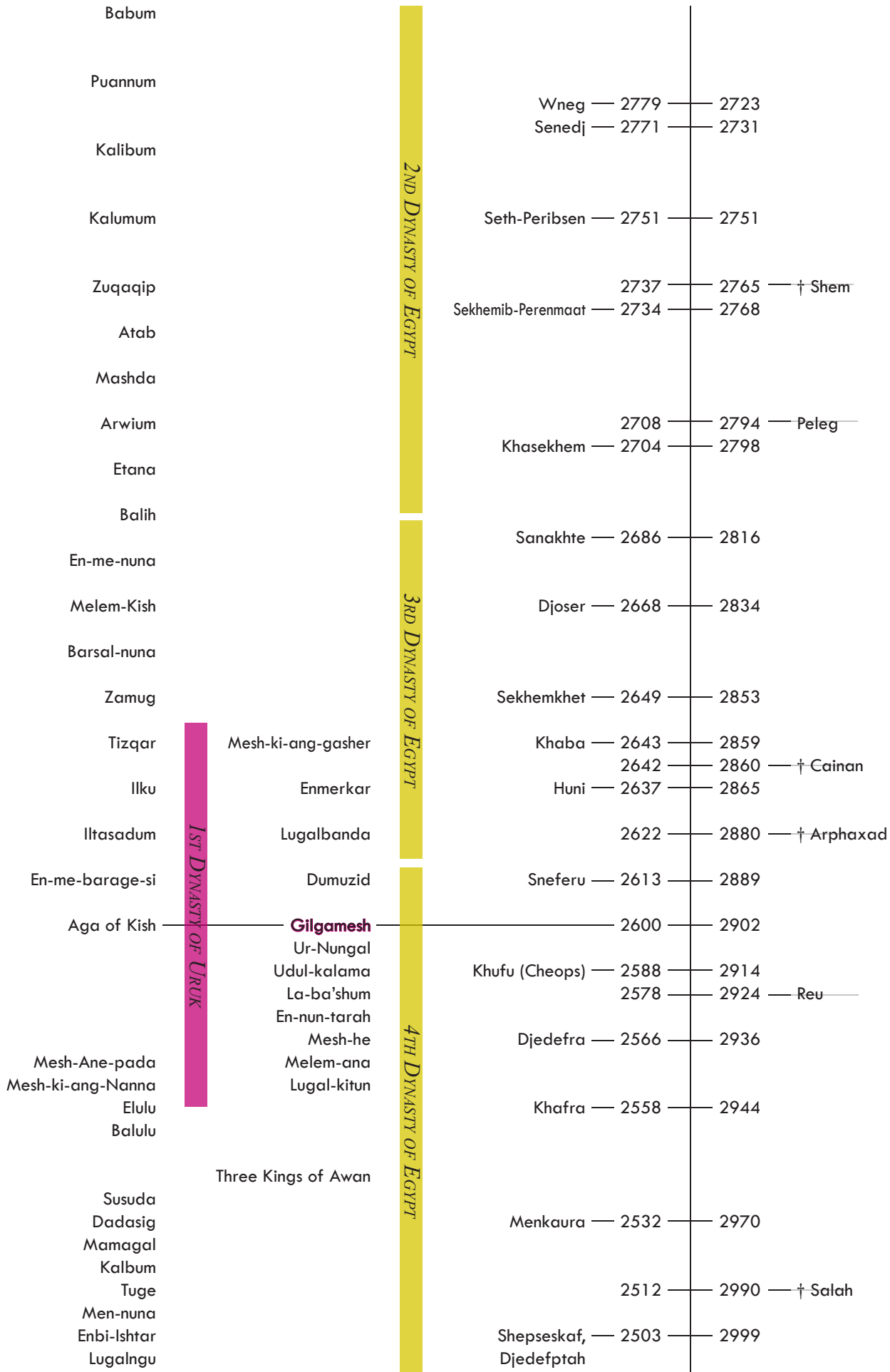
